All new members must serve a Probationary period, the length of which is to be determined by the club committee on their shooting experience. Non FAC holders must attend at least EIGHT shoots.

Current Club rules

- That the rules of conduct, membership and safety may, from time to time, be altered, deleted or added to. On any such occasion, the acceptance or rejection will be voted on at any General Meeting. The proposed rule will be advertised to members at least 14 days before the meeting.
- It is the responsibility of the members to sign the club range attendance register before shooting. Additional information may be required from time to time to comply with Government Statute and or Regulation.
- That during the time the club has the use of any authorised range, the range rules as are applicable to that
 range will be applied in full. Any transgression of any rule will be dealt with appropriately and the
 person/persons involved may be told to leave the range after due discussion by at least three (3) members,
 one of which will be a club Duty Range Conducting Officer or his duly appointed deputy.
- Any person attending an official club function and found to be or suspected to be in possession of any
 firearms or ammunition not listed on their personal certificate will be asked to prove the legal possession,
 and if firearms or ammunition is found to be illegally held, that person will be told to leave immediately.
 That person and the facts of the case will be reported to the committee with a view to expulsion from the
 club with the relevant authorities being informed.
- That all the firearms used at a meeting shall be in good order. All firearms may be examined by the Club
 Armourer, Range Conducting Officer or Club Officials, whether suspect or not, and shall not be used at club
 shoots unless passed as safe. At all times, all members will be responsible for their personal firearms and
 ammunition or Club firearms and ammunition issued to them on the day until returned to the club
 Armourer.
- That all small arms to be loaded within normal limits with reference to bullet and powder. If of the muzzle loading type only commercially made black powder, Pyrodex or BP substitute may be used. No firearm will be primed unless at the firing point and facing the bullet stoppers.
- That no loaded firearm will be left unattended on the range until discharged or made safe by withdrawal of the load.
- That every Full or Probationary member of the club must abide by the club and range rules unconditionally.
- That all members will wear club membership identification cards on ranges at all times.
- That the club officials have the right to ask a member for a sufficient number of rounds of ammunition of
 any calibre or type of cartridge being used and suspected of being overloaded or dangerous. Cases will be
 returned if possible after weighing and testing by a certified dealer or Proof House. If it is the case that the
 loads in question were dangerous the costs incurred will be charged to the individual concerned.
